2026 Event Safety Guidelines

At Fly'n For Fun 2026, the safety and well-being of all attendees are our top priorities. Please familiarise yourself with the following safety guidelines to ensure a secure and enjoyable experience for everyone:

1. Aircraft Operations:

- Pilots must adhere to all relevant aviation regulations and guidelines.
- Maintain a safe distance from active runways and taxiways.
- Live propellers are strictly prohibited within the event site under all circumstances. Please ensure all "No Live Prop" signage is clearly observed and strictly followed.
- Avoid taxiing or landing in non-designated areas.

2. Ground Operations:

- Exercise caution when walking around the event site, especially near aircraft and equipment.
- Keep pathways clear of obstructions to facilitate safe pedestrian flow.
- Follow designated routes and pathways to access various areas of the event.
- Be mindful of moving vehicles and equipment.
- Attendees are strictly prohibited within the "Live Prop" areas. Please ensure all "Live Prop" signage is clearly observed and strictly followed.

3. Emergency Procedures:

- Familiarise yourself with the location of emergency exits, first aid stations, and fire extinguishers.

- In case of an emergency, follow the instructions of event staff and emergency personnel.
- Report any accidents, injuries, or hazardous situations to event organisers immediately.

4. Weather Awareness:

- Stay informed about weather conditions and forecasts for the duration of the event.
- Monitor announcements and updates from event organisers regarding any changes to the schedule due to weather conditions.

5. General Safety:

- Be mindful of your surroundings and the actions of others, especially in crowded areas.
- Report any suspicious or concerning behaviour to event security or staff.
- Stay hydrated and take breaks as needed to prevent fatigue and dehydration.
- Always follow event rules and regulations to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone.
- RAAus reserves the right to remove attendees from the event premises if necessary for the safety and wellbeing of all participants.
- The licensed bar will operate in accordance with Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) guidelines to ensure the safety and responsible consumption of alcohol by all attendees.

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6. Children and Families:

- Children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
- Please keep children at a safe distance from aircraft, equipment, and restricted areas.
- Prams and strollers should not block walkways or emergency access routes.

7. Pets and Animals

- Pets are not permitted on the event site unless they are certified assistance animals.
- Assistance animals must be clearly always identified and remain on-leash.
